7th Annual Favorite Poem Project Poetry Readings

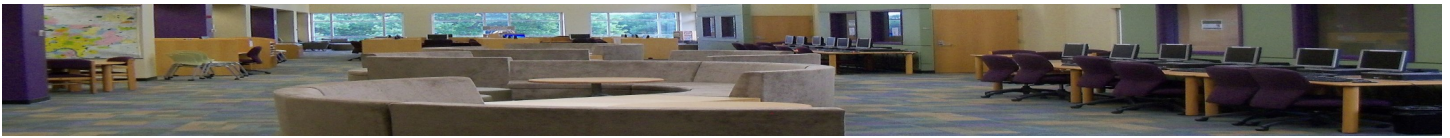
“Let Us Suddenly Proclaim Spring” — from “The Conspiracy” by Robert Creeley

At the top of the page, click on  Settings

Then click on "Library links" on the left-hand side of the page.


Next, search for Miami University and check the box next to "Miami University Libraries—Find It @MiamiOH". Click "Save" and you are good to go!
